

DCU research collaboration with OpenJaw Technologies



DCU has just begun a collaborative research project with OpenJaw Technologies. The project aims to incorporate the latest technologies from the Interoperable Systems Group in the School of Computing at DCU led by Dr. Mark Roantree, into OpenJaw's product portfolio.

OpenJaw is a leading Irish technology company and their products enable travel companies such as airlines, online travel agencies (OTAs), hotel chains and loyalty programmes to offer their products and services in the internet domain.

The company recently announced a plan to create 45 new jobs in Dublin and Galway as part of an Enterprise Ireland-supported €3.3m R&D investment. This collaboration with DCU will help maintain OpenJaw's leadership in this high growth online travel market.
