The Chair also thanked Ms Nicola O'Reilly for agreeing to join GRSB as the postgraduate student representative and for her contribution to the discussions and decisions of the Board.

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The Chair provided an update on Item 3.2, informing the Board that the Graduate Studies Office has conducted a survey of current postgraduate research students and alumni regarding the requirement to submit a hardcopy version of their thesis upon completion of the examination process. The Chair explained that each Associate Dean for Research (ADR) has also been requested to gather feedback from their respective Faculty Research Committee regarding the proposal to remove the requirement that postgraduate research students submit a hardcopy version of their thesis alongside the electronic version.

It was <u>noted</u> that data from the survey and feedback from the ADRs will be discussed at the October meeting of GRSB and used to inform the proposal on thesis submission procedures.

SECTION B: POLICY AND STRATEGY ISSUES

4. Graduate researcher development

4.1 Graduate Skills Sessions, September - October 2024

The Graduate Studies Office provided a list of the Graduate Skills Sessions that will be delivered in September and October 2024. The Chair requested the Associate Deans for Research to promote these sessions in their respective faculties.

5. Guidelines on PhD by Publication and PhD/Masters by Artefact or Creative Performance/Practice

5.1 Guidelines on PhD by Publication

The Chair called attention to specific revisions to the guidelines, in particular that the decision to submit 'by publication' should be made jointly by the candidate and the supervisor(s) at an early stage in the doctoral process, ideally in Year 1 but no later than the time of the confirmation/transfer examination; at least one publication should be reasonably expected to be in "Accepted" status by the time of the confirmation/transfer examination; and a candidate ought to have contributed at least 50% of effort to each of the three main publications included in the thesis. The Chair also informed the Board that the revised word count for PhD by Publication theses, i.e. 15,000-20,000 words, is benchmarked against those of other UK universities that accept this format of thesis.

<u>Decision Deferred</u> – It was <u>noted</u> that further revisions would be made to these guidelines following feedback from Registry and specific requests from members of the Board. The revised guidelines will be considered for approval electronically to allow for publication in time for the commencement of the new academic year.

5.2 Guidelines on PhD/Masters by Artefact or Creative Performance/Practice

The Chair informed the Board that the separate guidelines for PhD/Masters by Artefact and PhD/Masters by Creative/Performance Practice have been combined into a single set of guidelines due to the overlap between the two. The Chair called particular attention to the word count for PhD/Masters by Artefact or Creative Performance/Practice theses, i.e. 30,000 for PhD and 15,000 for Masters, which is benchmarked against those of other UK universities that accept these formats of theses.

<u>Decision Deferred</u> – It was <u>noted</u> that further revisions would be made to these guidelines following feedback from Registry and confirmation regarding the most appropriate title for PhD/Masters by creative and/or performance practice. The revised guidelines will be considered for approval electronically to allow for publication in time for the commencement of the new academic year.

6. Conference Presentation Grant

The Chair informed the Board that the Postgraduate Research Conference Presentation Grant has been revised by the Graduate Studies Office (GSO) to provide clear information to applicants. The Chair confirmed that the grant is available to postgraduate research students who are presenting at rather than just attending a conference, either in person or online.

It was <u>noted</u> that a student can make a maximum of two applications up to a total value of €500 and that students in receipt of external scholarships with dedicated funds for travel must use these before applying for the grant.

Two separate grounds for appeal have been combined into a single ground for appeal: "There was a failure to adhere to, or an insufficiency in the regulations contained in, *Academic Regulations for Postgraduate Degrees by Research and Thesis*".
