Courses

CTYI courses are academically challenging and allow students to meet and mix with like-minded peers. A wide range of courses, not ordinarily available in primary school, are available. CTYI have Centres offering Saturday and summer programmes in Dublin (DCU), Cork (UCC), Limerick (MIC), Athlone (TUS), Galway (NUIG), Sligo (ATU) and Waterford (SETU). Courses for 6-7 year olds are available in Dublin and Cork only. All eligible students will be notified of exact dates and locations before the start of each term.

Correspondence courses are also available to all children who qualify in assessment. Courses are conducted by means of email and can be done at home or in school. Students must have the help of a parent/guardian/teacher to facilitate their participation.

Assessment Details

All students wishing to participate in Centre for Talented Youth, Ireland (CTYI) courses, must first take an assessment to establish their eligibility. No preparation or revision is required. No materials are needed other than a pencil and an eraser. Assessment locations, dates and times can be found overleaf. Assessment for 8-12 year olds

Students in this age group sit three tests:

- Abstract Reasoning (20 mins)
- Verbal Reasoning (20 mins)
- Numerical Reasoning (20 mins)

The assessment takes 1 hour.

Assessment for 6-7 year olds

Students in this age group sit two tests:

- Abstract Reasoning (30 mins)
- Verbal Reasoning (20 mins)

Children must be able to read to take part. This assessment takes 1 hour to complete.

To Apply for an Assessment

Complete the application form **and return by post only no later than 10 working days** before your preferred assessment date. Applications received after this time will be assigned the next available date. Please note assessment dates cannot be changed.

Assessment Fee

The €50 assessment fee: payment may be made online by credit/debit card.
