

DENMARK

Visa requirements for Denmark

Aalborg University

Aalborg university is based in the city of Aalborg. It has approximately 20,000 students. Students can study courses in Humanities, Engineering and Natural Sciences. The university uses 'contextual knowledge' as its method for learning. This is where the students learn by doing projects and working in groups rather than the traditional lecture hall setting.

Tampere University - established in 2019 following the merger of University of Tampere and Tampere University of Technology. It is the second largest university in Finland with almost 22,500 students.

Tampere City is located between 2 lakes that are at different heights. The city has rapids (smaller lakes) that join the 2 lakes, taking into account the height difference. Much of its old industrial buildings have now been converted into coffee shops and offices. Tampere City is often referred to as the "Sauna Capital of the World" because of its large number of public saunas.

Getting to Tampere

There are no direct flights from Dublin to Tampere. However, a number of airlines fly to Helsinki which is approximately 2 hours from Tampere. From there you can either get a connecting flight to Tampere-Pirkkala Airport or take a train.

INSA Lyon is among the top 150 universities in the World University Rankings for its teaching in Materials Science and Mechanical Engineering.

Dublin City University (DCU) - established as National Institute of Higher Education in 1975 it then went on to gain university status in 1989. It consists of 5 campuses all within a 2 km radius. In 2016 DCU incorporated 4 other educational institutions bringing the current DCU student population to over 20,000.

Dublin

Dublin is the capital of Ireland, situated on the east coast of the country. Although it is one of the smaller counties in Ireland it is largest city. Dublin has the largest city park in Europe, Phoenix Park which is spread over 1,750 acres. It is home to the President of Ireland and the American Ambassador to Ireland. It is also the location of Dublin Zoo and other significant monuments, houses and gardens.

Getting to Dublin

Currently they have approximately 16,500 students. It is one of the most prestigious medium universities in Italy. It has strong connections with universities in Asia, America, the Middle East and Oceania.

Trento

Trento is the third largest Alpine city after Grenoble in France and Innsbruck in Austria. It is a picturesque city with lots of Medieval and Renaissance architecture. It is one of the wealthiest and most prosperous cities in Italy. Located in the Adige Valley and surrounded by mountains. Close by are some of the best ski resorts in the world.

Getting to Trento

There are no direct flights from Dublin to Trento. However, you can fly from Dublin to Verona and take the shuttle bus at Verona Airport to the train station in Verona and there get a train from Verona to Trento.

KAUNAS UNIVERSITY OF TECHNOLOGY - originally established as the University of Lithuania in the city of Kaunas in 1922. Following many years of conflict, economic challenges and name changes' the university was given its current name, Kaunas University of Technology in 1991. It has over 9,000 students, with 6.5% coming from outside Lithuania. Since 2009 diplomas from the university have become recognised across Europe.

University of Twente - located in the city of Enschede. It was originally set up as Twente Polytechnical College in 1961. It was renamed University of Twente in 1984 following changes to the Dutch Academic Education Act. The location was chosen based on the large manufacturing industry in the area and the decline in the textile industry at the time. University of Twente is one of the top 200 most prestigious universities in the world according to the Times Higher Education Ranking.

Enschede is the largest city in the east of The Netherlands with a population of over 160,000. It is just a few kilometers from the border with Germany so many of the people living in Enschede also speak fluent German. In 2005 it received university status and was renamed University of Stavanger. It has approximately 12,000 students and 2,000 staff. It is located in the city of Stavanger.

Stavanger

Stavanger is one of the oldest cities in Norway. Located in the southwest of Norway, approximately 7 hours from Oslo. Often listed as one of the most expensive cities in the world to live in. It is the base for many domestic and international military organisations, including the NATO Warfare Centre. For many years Stavanger's main industry was shipping, ship building and fish canning.

Getting to Stavanger

There are no direct flights from Dublin to Stavanger. But you can fly from Dublin to Heathrow, Amsterdam, Copenhagen or Oslo and then get a connecting flight to Stavanger. Information on getting from Stavanger airport to the city centre is available HERE

You could alternatively fly Dublin to Oslo and then take a very scenic 7 hour train journey to Stavanger. If you travel overnight on the train you can book a sleeping compartment. Further information on the trains is available **HERE**

Lodz University of Technology - originally established in May 1945 consisting of Chemistry, Mechanical, Electrical and Textile Engineering programmes. There were 525 students in the first year the college opened. In 2024 there were approximately 18,000 students.

Lodz

Lodz is in the centre of Poland approximately 120 km southwest of Warsaw. It is known internationally for its National Film School. In 2017 it was inducted into the UNESCO Creative Cities Network and is often referred to as UNESCO City of Film. Piotrkowska Street located in Lodz is one of the longest streets in Europe measuring 4.6 km.

University of Aveiro - originally established in 1973. It currently has a student population of over 17,000 and more than 2,000 staff. The university is split over 3 campuses, the main campus being in Aveiro. The other 2 campuses are in the cities of Águeda and Oliveira de Azeméis, both are only 30 minutes by bus or train from Aveiro.

AVEIRO

Aveiro coastline is along the Atlantic Ocean. Like Venice it has many canals and boats so is often referred to as 'The Venice of Portugal'. Aveiro was for many years known for its salt production. The boats that they now use for transporting passengers had previously been used for harvesting salt from sea water.

Getting to Aveiro

There are no direct flights from Dublin to Aveiro. The best way to get there is to fly from Dublin to Porto which is just over an hour from Aveiro. You can take the bus, metro or taxi from Porto Airport to the city centre which is approximately 11 km away, further information is available HERE. Then take a train from Porto city to Aveiro, further information is available HERE.
