1. Programme-specific rules and requirements

The final degree award is calculated on performance in years 2, 3 and 4, in the ratio 20:40:40 respectively. The mark to be used for each year is the overall weighted average based on the first attempt at the relevant approved modules. In cases where this overall weighted average is less than 40% and the student has subsequently successfully completed the requisite credits, a mark of 40% will be used.

2. Derogations from Marks & Standards

3. Progression

Normally, students must successfully have completed a minimum of 60 credits in a study period in order to progress to the next study period. Students will not be permitted to 'carry' modules under any circumstances.

4. Compensation
